Why Incentives/Rebates Matter

Larger productions WILL NOT come without incentives.

Large projects serve as a catalyst to:

- Attract & retain qualified and experienced cast & crew.
- > Retain & grow infrastructure (i.e. equipment, vendors, facilities, etc....)
- > Provides valuable experience to cast & crew base.
- > Ensures that infrastructure, talent & crew will be here for other productions that don't qualify for incentives... such as commercial & industrial productions, indigenous independent filmmakers, etc...





TMIIIP funding will be crucial to retain 2 high profile projects in Dallas. USA's 3rd season of "Queen of the South" (\$21M+ local spending) & Fox's new Marvel TV series (est. \$35M+ local spending) along with many others....

LOST SPENDING TO TEXAS/DFW REGION IN FISCAL YEAR 2016 \$219M - 14 Projects

The approximate amount of spending lost from projects indicating they wanted to shoot in DFW region but could not do so without state incentives. This figure only includes the projects that are known, not those that didn't call because they knew about the reduction &/or unavailability of funds.
