

Baby Boom at Medical City

June births set 12-year record

WHAT:

There's a baby boom at Medical City! June was the biggest month yet, with more babies born here in that month than Medical City's seen in 12 years. Births were up 25% from June of last year, with 300 babies born. Births year to date are up seven percent.
