Dallas Contemporary announces daily screenings of new video works on the American Airlines Center Plaza Screens. The screenings will feature work by **JOSHUA BIENKO** and **JASON REED**, two artists who contributed to the **LOS AMERICANOS EXHIBITION** at Dallas Contemporary. LOS AMERICANOS is a video exhibition with newly commissioned projects by six Texas-based artists, which opened 19 January 2013. The screenings at American Airlines Center are in line with Dallas Contemporary's ongoing mission to integrate contemporary art into the community.

Peter Doroshenko, Dallas Contemporary director, states: "We have made it an important aspect of our exhibition programming to take contemporary art outside the museum walls and into the community. Showing video artworks at the American Airlines Center will not only reach a wide, new audience but will have over-the-top visual impact."

Dallas Contemporary has mounted major projects in the community since Doroshenko's arrival in 2010 including the Shepard Fairey city-wide mural project; installations inside the Neiman Marcus windows by Dallas graffiti collective Sour Grapes and Swiss artist Sylvie Fleury; and the Dallas Biennale - a multi-venue exhibition of eighteen artists from nine countries.

ABOUT THE ARTISTS EXHIBITING AT AMERICAN AIRLINES CENTER

JOSHUA BIENKO:

After graduating from the Lamar Dodd School of Art at the University of Georgia, New York native Joshua Bienko moved to College Station, Texas in 2008 to teach in the Department of Visualization at Texas A&M University. He is currently an Assistant Professor of Drawing at the University of Tennessee's School of Art in Knoxville. His drawings, paintings, photographs and video works explore themes of desire and obsession in sports, music and fashion, and often reference icons of popular culture. His work has been shown across the United States and internationally in Australia and the United Kingdom.

JASON REED:

Jason Reed holds a Bachelor of Arts in Geography from the University of Texas-Austin and a Master of Fine Arts in Photography from Illinois State University. He is currently Assistant Professor of Photography at Texas State University and co-director of Borderland Collective, a youth art project in the American Southwest. Reed has participated in collaborative and solo exhibitions in Texas, New Mexico, New York, Illinois, and Mexico. His work explores the complex landscape of politics and culture through various modes of lens-based representation.
